

MEDICATION INFORMATION SHEET

GENERIC: IBUPROFEN 200 MG

BRAND NAME: MOTRIN, ADVIL

Ibuprofen 200 mg is a pain reliever with the added benefit of anti-inflammatory properties. Ibuprofen helps reduce postoperative swelling that is associated with oral surgery.

We recommend taking 600 mg of ibuprofen every 6 hours. This is equivalent to taking 3 tablets of Advil, Motrin, or generic ibuprofen 200 mg. Taking 3 ibuprofen tablets will give optimum pain relief and swelling reduction and should be taken continuously, every 6 hours, for up to 3 days following surgery. If your discomfort is not relieved with ibuprofen alone, then you can supplement with a narcotic pain reliever if prescribed.

A common side effect for ibuprofen is stomach burning or irritation. If you have stomach discomfort, please discontinue this medication and call the doctor.

We recommend that you familiarize yourself with this medication by reading the package insert and/or information provided by your pharmacist.
